

WHAT IS MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS?

Multiple Sclerosis (MS) interrupts the flow of information from the brain to the body and stops people from moving. Every hour in the United States, someone is newly diagnosed with MS, an unpredictable, often disabling disease of the central nervous system. Symptoms range from numbness and tingling to blindness and paralysis. The progress, severity, and specific symptoms of MS in any one person cannot yet be predicted, but advances in research and treatment are moving us closer to a world free of MS.

Most people with MS are diagnosed between the ages of 20 and 50, with more than twice as many women as men contracting the disease. MS affects more than 400,000 people in the United States, and 2.5 million worldwide.

MS is the #1 disabling disease among young adults in the United States.

NATIONAL MS SOCIETY

Since its founding in 1946, the National Multiple Sclerosis Society has been the leader in the fight against MS. The National Multiple Sclerosis Society supports more MS research, offers more services for people with MS, provides more professional educational programs, and furthers more MS advocacy efforts than any other MS organization in the world.

The Michigan Chapter is one of a 50-state network of chapters and branches that represent the National MS Society. The Chapter offers education, support, community and wellness programs to people living with MS across the state. We serve more than 18,000 people who live with MS as well as their families, friends, caregivers and healthcare providers.

From 2007 to 2008, the number of cases that were reported to the Michigan Chapter increased 12%. It is more important than ever to raise the funds needed so that we can effectively serve those living with MS here in Michigan.

EVENT DETAILS

Bike MS is the largest organized cycling event in the country. Over 100,000 cyclists participate in more than 100 Rides across the United States.

Celebrating our 23rd anniversary this year, the Great Lakes Breakaway Bike MS will host 2,000 cyclists and volunteers at three ride events.

Unlike a racing event, Bike MS is designed to provide a scenic, challenging ride for both the experienced cyclist and the energetic novice. Depending on which Ride location you choose, participants are offered a choice of fully-supported routes that vary between 30-100 miles over the two ride days.

Bike MS 2009 takes place in West Michigan in June in Holland, Michigan. The Mid-Michigan Bike MS Ride takes place in July where riders begin in Fenton, Michigan with the overnight location at Michigan State University in Lansing. The Mountain Bike MS Ride will be held on September 12th at the Island Lake State Recreation Area.




